Landfill stickers for sale

Thursday, June 22, 2006

Applications for fiscal 2007 landfill and/or recycling stickers for Wayland residents are available at the Landfill and Recycling Center at 484 Boston Post Road, Town Hall lobby, Board of Health office or online at "www.wayland.ma.us/boh". Stickers may be purchased beginning June 24 at the landfill in the office trailer. Payment must be made by check payable to the "Town of Wayland." Cash will not be accepted.

Stickers will be sold only between 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday. There will be no admittance to the landfill with the current FY06 permits beyond July 31.

Although disposal costs and fuel and utility prices continue to escalate, the Board of Health has maintained the base 2007 landfill sticker fees at the prior year's level. The cost for a full landfill sticker will be \$220 for the first vehicle and \$25 for an additional vehicle at the same address. Senior citizen stickers are \$165 to any resident who reaches age 65 on or before July 31, 2006. Recycling only stickers will remain at \$10 and single trip permits will remain at \$35.

There are several new fees and policies, which become effective July 1, 2006. All trucks will be charged a surcharge fee of \$50. In addition, trailers will now be classified as additional vehicles and will be required to purchase a \$25 additional vehicle sticker with the trailer registration required. There will now be a limit of three landfill stickers per household (one full

sticker and two additional vehicle stickers).

Electronics will continue to be collected once a month on the first Saturday of the month, with a \$25 fee for each refrigerator/freezer, air conditioner, dehumidifier, television, computer and monitor. Because new state waste ban regulations prohibit the disposal of wood in the landfill and recycling costs of wood have increased significantly, the landfill will conduct one final Wood Collection Day on Saturday, July 15. After that date, the landfill will not accept any construction or demolition wood, wood furniture or any wood products. A list of vendors offering wood disposal options for a fee is available at the landfill.

With the help of our residents, Wayland continues to be among the top recycling communities in the state. Detailed information on new policies and a summer calendar will be provided to each resident who purchases a sticker.
