








an all-or-nothing override vote, lumped priorities of life and limb with priorities of convenience and status. This is why Massachusetts allows its citizens menu override ballot questions."

Tichnor said he expects a large voter turnout at Town Meeting now that both the override and the Town Center project will be up for a vote.

"It's not often the voters in town have the opportunity to make such an impact on the town's future," he said.
